## **RESIDENTS' MEETING**

The Federal Government has created a national competition for \$1 BILLION dollars in funding designed to assist communities to become more resilient to disasters. New Jersey is applying for more than \$326 million dollars in funds for berms in the Meadowlands, a NJTransit Garage in Teterboro and Resiliency Planning Assistance to municipalities throughout the state. This application\* proposes a pilot project area in the municipalities of Carlstadt, East Rutherford, Hackensack, Hasbrouck Heights, Little Ferry, Moonachie, Rutherford, South Hackensack, Teterboro, and Wood-Ridge.

It is critical that the State hear everyone's thoughts on how this money should be spent. This project will affect our neighborhoods, schools, businesses, and quality of life.
