Brown is perhaps best known for playing the lead in the 1979 television production of "Captain America" and the action war film "Uncommon Valor". He is also known for the 1983 cult classic, "Yor, the Hunter from the Future", regarded as a B-Movie classic, as well as the sci-fi film, "Space Mutiny" Sci-Fi film, and for the collaborations with director Bruno Mattei in films "Strike Commando" and "Robowar".

#### CHRIS BREWSTER - ACTOR / STUNTMAN / STUNT COOR-DINATOR

After meeting several high level stuntmen, Chris decided this is the career he was meant to pursue. His martial arts, gymnastics, and parkour training lended itself very well to the stunt world. Over the next 13 years, he was given the opportunity to work in over 150 movies and television shows.

**PHIL ORTIZ** - Come and be Sketchanized by Phil and see what you would look like if you were to appear as a character on the Simpsons. Phil was a designer on the first 2 seasons of the show and is responsible for designing many of the characters such as Apu, Flanders, Otto, Herman, Lou and Eddie, and Ralph. The cost is \$70 per person and that includes penciling, Inking and professional coloring so you will have an amazing piece of art that you will keep for the rest of your life.. featuring you or you and your family!


MIKE TOTH - began his long career in the animation field in 1978 at Filmation Studios. Having been inspired by the Warner Brothers cartoons of the 1940s he always dreamed of being an animator. Starting his career at Filmation Studios he worked on He-Man and the Masters of the Universe, She-Ra Princess of Power, Fat Albert and the Cosby Kids, Tarzan, Lone Ranger Zorro Adventure Hour, Shazam, Blackstar, Bravestarr, Ghostbusters, New Adventures of Tom & Jerry. He also worked freelance for Bill Melendez on This is America Charlie Brown, Snoopy's Reunion and It's Spring Training Charlie Brown.When Filmation closed it's doors in 1988 he moved over to the Baer Animation Studios

**TOM COOK** - began his career as an animator and director in 1978 at Hanna-Barbera Studios where he was hired to work as an assistant animator on Challenge of the SuperFriends, Godzilla, Scooby Doo, Smurfs, Pacman and the Flintstones. A short stop at Ruby-Spears had him working on Thundarr the Barbarian (had the privilege to meet and work with Jack Kirby), Heathcliff, Fang Face and Plastic Man. Freelancing at Film Roman he worked on the Garfield Special Babes and Bullets and for Bill Melendez on the Peanuts Special This is America Charlie Brown. He then moved over to Filmation Studios in 1980.

**SCOTT ROSEMA** - Graduated from Kendall College of Art & Design in 1979. He has since made a name for himself as an artist and illustrator. Scott is most famous for drawing Space Ghost in the late 90s Archie Comics. Sadly it was a short run as Archie Comics lost the rights shortly after. Before Space Ghost, Scott work with Warner Bros. International Publishing on Tiny Toons/ Looney Toons comic books. Some of his work included Batman: The Animated Series Gold Book "Terror of Two-Face"; X-Men Adventures Season II; Rogue & Storm pinup poster; Disney Comic Hits; Solar, Man of Atom and many others.

**MIKE GASAWAY** - is an award-winning Director with over 8 years of directing/producing experience, specializing in computer animation. He's directed on three award winning shows and has helped build 2 animation studios. The prequel to his first feature, a short film titled, Help Me First!, was shot in early spring and premiered with rave reviews at Fantastic Fest 2016.
