# DID YOU KNOW?

In Kingston, people speak lots of different languages. Your family and friends might speak more than one language! In 2010, something called a census took place in England, which collected lots of information about all the people who live here.

It found out that in 2010, these languages were spoken in Kingston...

0.7% of people speak German

1.7% of people speak Tamil

0.6% of people speak Spanish

1.3% of people speak Polish

1.7% of people speak Korean

83% of people speak English


